

Gregory Orchestra Supplies - 8th Grade (2018-2019)

Required Supplies from last year:

If your child still has these items in good condition, they do not need to be replaced. Please check in with your child. If you need to replace any of these supplies, items 1-4 are available at any store that sells office/school supplies. The remaining items are available at any local music store. Quinlan and Fabish Music, our preferred vendor, will conveniently deliver these items to your child at Gregory and can be ordered by calling 630-654-4111 or visiting www.qandf.com.

1. One 1" three-ring, hard cover binder with pockets on the inside (any color is fine, and label it with your child's name on the outside cover). This binder will be only for Orchestra/Music.
2. 5 Tabbed Dividers to clip into orchestra binder (Label sections as: Calendars, Orch. Music, Technique, Handouts, Extras)
3. 1 pencil bag that clips inside of the binder (a thin, inexpensive one is best so it is not too bulky)
4. 3-5 sharpened pencils or mechanical pencils
5. Orchestra Expressions Book 2 (your child may have given this to us for safekeeping over the summer; they will be handed back to students on Aug. 23rd)
6. Rosin (comes with all rentals; if broken or lost, ask your music store for a free replacement; if you own your violin, viola or cello, consider buying a higher quality rosin, such as Hill Dark rosin or Jade rosin.)
7. Violins & Violas – "Kun" Brand Shoulder Rest. All violin students should get 4/4 sized. All 14" or smaller viola students should get a 4/4-violin rest. All 15" or larger viola students should purchase a viola rest (ask for the type that does not collapse). The Everest brand shoulder rest is also excellent and comes in a variety of colors. We do recommend the collapsible version of the Everest rest. If your child takes private lessons and has a different rest, we are glad to discuss this with your child to see if a different shoulder rest will be acceptable for class. In most cases, private teachers have selected other great options that work well.
8. Cellos & Basses – Rock stop (comes with all rentals; if lost, ask your music store for a replacement)
9. Folding music stand (for proper home practice and some concerts – do not bring to school)
10. Bass players only – Pop's brand or Carlsson brand rosin
11. Instrument Tuner – PM Music Brand Tuner/Metronome
 - a. If your tuner is in good, working condition then you are set.
 - b. If your tuner needs new batteries, replace them now! The PM Tuner/Metronome uses triple A.
 - c. If your tuner is missing or broken, please replace with the PM Tuner/Metronome with Clip (only available at PM Music Center near the Fox Valley Mall; for your convenience, if you call (630) 978-9927 by August 31st to place your order, this will be delivered to Gregory in time for supply checks) Device can be viewed here: <https://tinyurl.com/orchtuner>. If your phone order includes any books or supplies, they will be delivered to school as well. Be sure to call on or before August 31st.
